Learn how to pray with IMPACT in the nations

Join us in interceding for the apple of the Lord's eye and learn how to pray insightfully for what God is doing in the nations today. Meet and support faithful workers who are labouring in the harvestfield to see God's kingdom come in Israel and the Middle East.

Typical Bootcamp Itinerary

[B=breakfast, L=lunch, D=dinner]

Depart Australia.

Day 1 - Arrive in Israel. We'll have a welcome meeting and check-in to our hotel on the Dead Sea. Dinner and early night. [D]

Day 2 - Head out into the **Negev** to reflect on the 'Desert Fathers' of the faith and modern Israel, visiting **Abraham's well of faith at Beersheba** and **Ben Gurion's Sde Boker homestead**. We will exegete the Hebrew link between 'word' and 'wilderness', understanding the Biblical role of the desert as the place where God speaks. After reflecting on our ANZAC forebears at **Australian Soldier Park** we'll return to our hotel on the Dead Sea. [B, D]

Day 3 - We'll spend our morning praying and worshipping in the **Judean Wilderness**. After **lunch at a Bedouin Camp** we'll visit the **Fountain of Tears**, an artistic sculpture exploring the connection between Jesus' suffering on the Cross and the Jewish Holocaust. Returning to the **Dead Sea, you'll be able to enjoy an afternoon/sunset float in the mineral-rich waters**. [B, L, D]

Day 4 - Having tasted the tears in the desert at the Earth's lowest elevation, we'll ascend on a cable car to the desert fortress of **Masada**, site of a mass Jewish suicide under Roman oppression. Here **Brian Pickering** will teach us the first of two onsite sessions. We'll contemplate our Lord's plan for the redemption of the Jewish people as we make our way up to **Jerusalem** and visit the incredibly evocative **Garden of Gethsemane**. Giving you time for personal reflection on the greatest day in history, we'll then enter **within the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem** to the strategically important **Christ Church**, the oldest Protestant church in the Middle East. Staying in the Christ Church Guesthouse for the next three nights, directly opposite the **Citadel and David's Tower**, is a highlight. [B, D]

Day 5 - Waking up to the sights and sounds of the Old City of Jerusalem we'll begin our two-day **Isaiah 19 Highway Conference**. You'll have the pleasure of hearing from the Rector **David Pileggi**, who will give us a brief **history of CMJ** (Christian Mission to the Jews) and the church, with **Ben Gray** teaching on the **Isaiah 19 Highway - A Bigger Vision for the Middle East**. [B, L, D]



Join the great ANZAC tradition of laying your life down for others

As we honour our forebears and their sacrifice, we're calling forth a new army to arise from Australia that will not take a step backwards against our enemy. God is releasing new strategy for blessing Israel and the Middle East that will overcome the bloodshed, division and wars that it's infamous for.

Day 6 - Today we'll conclude our Isaiah 19 Highway Conference. In the morning take part in a **mercy ministry reaching out to Muslims in East Jerusalem** at Pastor Mazen Nasrawi's church, and later visiting the **Western Wall, Garden Tomb** and joining in 24-7 prayer & worship with **Rick Ridings at Succat Hallel**. [B, L, D]

Day 7 - We'll drive north to *Eitan Shishkoff's* ministry **Tents of Mercy** to hear teaching from a respected Messianic congregational leader. After lunch, we'll **prayer-walk the streets of Haifa** before visiting the Louis Promenade with **incredible views over the city**, before returning to our hotel in Haifa. [B, L, D]

Day 8 - Our day begins in **Megiddo** for an onsite study: *The Harvestfield Comes Before the Battlefield*. After lunch we drive to the northern border overlooking Lebanon and Syria to **visit serving Israeli soldiers**. As Shabbat approaches we'll check-in to our **resort hotel near the Sea of Galilee** [B, D]



Day 9 - After breakfast, we'll head to **Nazareth**, for a **prayer meeting with Ps Nizar and his fellow Arab pastors**. After we've had lunch together, we'll give you the afternoon off to feel the rhythm of Shabbat, spend time with God and others as you take in this incredible location at our resort hotel in the Galilee. [B, L, D]

Day 10 - In the morning we'll visit **Capernaum**, Jesus' home town, to worship and do some **onsite study on the shores of the Galilee**. We'll travel down the coast to the metropolis of **Tel Aviv**, which is normally overlooked by Christian tourists even though half the population of Israel lives there. Overnight in Tel Aviv. [B, D]

Day 11 - We'll visit a Messianic ministry before visiting the **old city of Jaffa** to intercede for breakthrough in Tel Aviv. Late afternoon we'll head off to spend our last two nights at a **Judean hillside retreat**. [B, D]

Day 12 - After breakfast, we'll hear from *David Nekrutman* from the **Center for Jewish-Christian Understanding and Cooperation**. Later, we'll reflect on our Bootcamp experiences. [B, L, D]

Day 13 - Depart for airport for flight home to Australia. [B]
